

Paint the landscape in soft pastels with Maggie Price

Whether you're a beginner and want to learn the basics of painting landscapes in soft pastel, or whether you're an experienced pastelist and want new information, tips, techniques and ideas...this is the workshop for you!

Daily demonstrations and personal assistance at your easel, plus a wealth of information about techniques, methods and supplies, will help you improve your pastel paintings. The five-day session will include indoor exercises, techniques and instruction; painting on location, with demonstrations, if weather permits. The area is filled with beautiful marshes and rivers, and endless subject matter for outdoor painting. Tuition for 5 days: \$450; \$100 deposit due on registration. Materials list and information about lodging options will be provided upon registration. Limit 15 students.

Maggie Price is a co-founder and former editor of *The Pastel Journal*, an internationally-distributed magazine for pastelists, and the author of *Painting in Pastels* (2007, North Light Books). Author of over 90 articles about pastel art and artists, she is a Signature Member of the Pastel Society of America, the Pastel Society of New Mexico, and Plein Air New Mexico, and serves on the Board of Directors and is Vice President of the International Association of Pastel Societies. She frequently juries exhibitions and teaches workshops both in the United States and abroad.
